COURSE INFORMATION

This course is required for plumbers to obtain the backflow endorsement for their licence.

COURSE OUTCOME

Upon successful completion of this course participants will receive a Statement of Attainment in CPCPWT4022A - Commission and maintain backflow prevention devices. This competency forms part of CPC40912 Certificate IV in Plumbing and Services.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must hold a current Queensland plumbing licence from the Queensland Building and Construction Commission (QBCC) with a backflow endorsement that is due to expire in three to six months.

COURSE PREREQUISITES

There are no prerequisites for this course.

COURSE OUTLINE

This course provides learners with the skills and knowledge required to test, commission and maintain backflow prevention devices in water services. It covers the identification of requirements, preparation of work, commissioning and maintenance activities, and finalisation of work including documentation.

Training is delivered face-to-face.

- The identification of testing and commissioning requirements
- The physical testing and commissioning of devices
- Maintenance of devices and the completion of work finalisation processes
