COURSE INFORMATION

If you're working in the construction industry, it is compulsory to complete a nationally recognised **General Construction Induction Training** course. Previously called a Construction White Card, the course (CPCWHS1001 - Prepare to work safely in the construction industry) specifies the mandatory work health and safety training required to undertake work in the construction industry throughout Australia.

This course provides training and assessment in the following units of competency:

CPCWHS1001

Prepare to work safely in the construction industry

COURSE OUTCOME

Upon successful completion of this course participants will be sent a Statement of Attainment for CPCWHS1001 - Prepare to work safely in the construction industry and issued with a General Construction Induction Training Card (White Card).

COURSE PREREQUISITES

There are no prerequisites for this course.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

100 Points of identification must be submitted upon enrolment.

COURSE OUTLINE

This unit requires the participant to demonstrate personal awareness and knowledge of health and safety legislative requirements in order to work safely and prevent injury or harm to self and others.

It covers identifying and orally reporting common construction hazards, understanding basic risk control measures, and identifying procedures for responding to potential incidents and emergencies. It also covers correctly selecting and fitting common personal protective equipment (PPE) used for construction work.

- Risk Management and Control Measures in the Construction Industry
- Incident and Emergency Response Procedures
- WHS Communication, Documentation and Reporting Processes
